## High Noise Immunity, 3.3V/5V, 10 Mbit/sec Logic Gate Output (Open Collector) Optocoupler

## **FODM8061**

#### Description

The FODM8061 is a 3.3 V/5 V high–speed logic gate output (open collector) optocoupler, which supports isolated communications allowing digital signals to communicate between systems without conducting ground loops or hazardous voltages. It utilizes **onsemi**'s patented coplanar packaging technology, OPTOPLANAR<sup>®</sup>, and optimized IC design to achieve high noise immunity, characterized by high common mode transient immunity specifications.

This optocoupler consists of an AlGaAS LED at the input, optically coupled to a high speed integrated photo-detector logic gate. The output of the detector IC is an open collector schottky-clamped transistor. The coupled parameters are guaranteed over the wide temperature range of  $-40^{\circ}$ C to  $+110^{\circ}$ C. A maximum input signal of 5mA will provide a minimum output sink current of 13 mA (fan out of 8).
